Our programs do more than provide resources—they foster meaningful connections that empower individuals to achieve their dreams. Here are examples of how we use donor funds to build impactful relationships and create the positive change we strive for.

\$50K	Transportation: Provides reliable, safe and easy access to tutoring for K-12 students
\$25K	Case Management: Offers personalized support through one-on-one and small group circles to guide adults toward self-sufficiency and personal goals
\$10K	Outreach: Reaches Chicago's most vulnerable individuals by bringing food and clothing to people experiencing street homelessness
\$5K	Love of Reading: Provides a library of classic and contemporary books, encouraging young readers and fostering connections between tutors and students
\$2.5K	Market Voucher Program: Eliminates barriers to fresh produce by offering no cost purchase and delivery of fresh produce grown in our Urban Farm
